COURSE CONTENT

This course will instruct gynaecologic oncologists and fellows in the techniques required for resection of ovarian and other gynaecologic cancers involving the bowel and upper abdominal organs

OBJECTIVES

Resection of all macroscopic disease gives the best survival for women with advanced ovarian cancer. The objectives of this course are:

To understand the surgical anatomy of upper abdominal and gastro-intestinal organs

To become skilled in surgical procedures for performance of radical resection of ovarian malignancies metastatic to the abdomen, bowel and pelvis

To identify methods to avoid and treat complications of these procedures

PROCEDURES

- Resection of liver tumors
Dissection of porta hepatis, lesser sac and celiac trunk
Splenectomy and distal pancreatectomy
Diaphragm stripping, resection, repair
Resection of cardiophrenic lymph nodes
Bowel resection and anastomosis
Bowel bypass procedures
Stoma formation and reversal
Radical oophorectomy with en bloc resection of rectosigmoid
Peritonectomy procedures
